Confession - Psalm 91 NLT (JHB/WTB): I who live in the shelter of The Most High will find rest in the shadow of the Almighty. This I declare about the Lord: He alone is my refuge, my place of safety, He is my God and I trust in Him. For He will rescue me from every trap and protect me from deadly disease. He will cover me with His feathers. He will shelter me with His wings. His faithful promises are my armour and protection. I am not afraid of the terrors of the night, nor the arrow that flies in the day. I do not dread the disease that stalks in darkness, nor the disaster that strikes at midday. Though a thousand fall at my side, though ten thousand are dying around me, these evils will not touch me. This includes the coronavirus. I just open my eyes, and see how the wicked are punished. I make the Lord my refuge, I make The Most High my shelter, no evil will conquer me; no plague will come near my home. For He will order His angels to protect me wherever I go. They will hold me up with their hands so I won't even hurt my foot on a stone. I will trample upon lions and cobras; I will crush fierce lions and serpents under my feet! The Lord says, He will rescue me - who loves Him. He will protect me - who trusts in His Name. When I call on Him, He will answer; He will be with me in trouble. He will rescue and honor me. He will reward me with a long life and give me His salvation. I don't pay much attention to what's happening in the world right now. Medical advice says I need to be cautious about how I touch people. This is a good time to listen to what the medical profession tells me to do. I listen but I trust in the Word of God more than I trust in what is happening out there in the world. My first barriers is to use the Word of God. I trust that as I speak the Word of God and an airborne disease comes near me, that actual virus strain dies before it hits me or as it lands on my body it dies. This is my faith – that it will not get hold of me. I still wash my hands and I'm careful and do the things that I should be doing but my trust is in the Lord. I don't let go of this Word and I don't look at natural circumstances. If I stay in the Word of God and I keep Psalm 91 in front of my eyes, this disease, this plague, this thing, will not come near me. That means my finances as well as my physical body. I trust the God of Psalm 91. Amen (Audio Available).



The medical profession tells me: to keep surfaces clean in my home and wherever I go; to sneeze or cough into my elbow and make sure I'm protected and covered when other people do; not to shake people's hands, not to touch my eyes, nose, mouth and face and wash my hands often with soap.



**Mobile: (JHB)** I go into this season of the new door where God has got supernatural increase waiting for me in every area of my life but I've got to be moving (mobile). I can't be stuck like my feet are in cement. If my spirit, my attitude is stuck in cement, I change it. If my spirit-life is stuck in the past or in what I'm experiencing right now (current status) then I can't receive what God is bringing to me because I won't see it. I say: I'm ready for the blessing Lord.







**<u>Project conditioning: (WTB/JHB)</u>** Conditioning is spiritual conditioning, physical conditioning, financial conditioning and relationship conditioning.



**The Word: (WTB)** I cannot judge the Word and the Truth of God's Word by someone else's experience. If I do that I'm saying someone else's experience is more valuable to me than the Word. People's experiences must be judged by the Word of God. The Word of God is more real than someone's experience because I don't have all the details of what really happened in that person's life, even though I may think so.



**Put God first: (WTB)** When I put God first and I follow the order of His life and He is my first Love, then the blessing that is upon me is so powerful that it draws unbelievers, resources, circumstances to me that I couldn't plan, ask for or arrange. God will bring it to me because He is The Most High God and orders things in the universe to make sure I'm blessed but I have to get out of my comfort zone. This blessing mantle just attracts things into my life.

**Divine communication (WTB):** There is a divine communication that I can have because I am putting myself out there to do the things that God wants me to do. I'm ready to take myself out of many comfort zones.



<u>6 Points (WTB/JHB):</u> 1) I do not compare; 2) I prevent comfort zone crime; 3) I don't connect to the past to tell me (for confirmation of) what is happening to my future. 4) I'm unchained from what I'm experiencing right now (my current status) and look for a status God wants for my life; 5) I walk, see, talk covenant future. I don't talk what the world is talking, especially not now; 6) I'm courageous and obedient to His guidance.

<u>**Read:</u>** Acts 10:44-48 AMPC. Peters life shows me that I shouldn't live in my weaknesses, I should live in the strength that God has given me because my assignment and my purpose is in my strength, not in my weakness. If I let my weakness dominate my life then I will never fulfil what God wants for my life. When it comes to my new door, I need to be brave, courageous and bold and walk through doors.</u>



<u>My new door (WTB)</u>: The new door that the Lord has for me is not something I am going to wonder about. It is not going to be perplexing, confusing and I'm not going to doubt it. It's going to be clear, something I can obviously see. I will know it spiritually before I see it naturally. When God speaks something very strongly to my spirit, I'm ready to act on it.



<u>5 Points (WTB/JHB)</u>: 1) *I have to recognize this moment fully*, it is a significant and spiritual moment. 2) *Revelation must continue through conversation and action*. The Word becomes real to me through the messages (revelation) and I continue to talk about these things and keep them coming out of my mouth and it drives me to action. 3) I must reflect on my daily commitment to this season. I do something every day so the revelations grow. I don't leave it for tomorrow. I'm led by the Holy Spirit right now to see things that I couldn't otherwise see. 4) *I must respond to both small and large Bible (what I see in the Word) and Holy-Spirit changes (what He is talking to me personally about).* 5) *I rejoice always* and give thanks. To rejoice is a command. When I'm feeling bad, I get out of it by rejoicing. The power of rejoicing is always when I don't feel good but I do it anyway. I give thanks for what my circumstances will look like because His Word is about to change my future.





**The Blood:** God doesn't want to bless me because I do everything right or because of how well I do. He wants to bless me because I'm covered by the Blood and He sees me through the Blood and the Blood has taken care of me because I'm a son of God.
