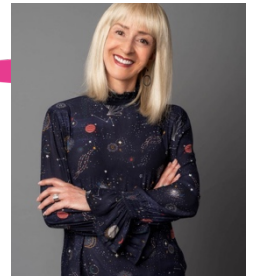

Read: Hebrews 10:19, TPT

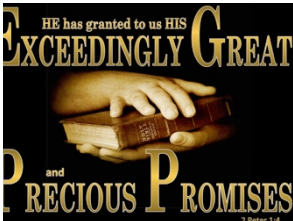


Tithe: What's in Pastor Sharon's heart fully comes in my heart in a brand-new way through this new open door with supernatural increase. I'm a faithful tither. I let my faith in God's promise regarding His tithe, soar to brand new heights. My love of His ways makes a new highway in my heart today. I sing and love Him deeply as I meditate on this message.



The scripture God gave Pastor Sharon comes from **Malachi 3:16-18 (AMPC)** and **Malachi 3:13-15 (ESV)**. It's two different sets of people, different sets of conversations.

I'm God's faithful tither: I'm a faithful tither and I exercise and enforce my rights in Your covenant. All God's promises about everything and anything are my rights. God knows me, I'm His faithful tither. He knows me by name and knows me personally. God publicly recognizes me. God openly declares me to be His jewel, His special possession and His peculiar treasure. God spares me as a man spares his own son who serves him. At this time, I will see that God will make a distinction (He separates me) between those who serve Him and those who don't. This is such good news for me as the tither, because He makes a distinction (like God's people living in Goshen separated from the Egyptians). God hears me because I fear Him. I talk often to others about my joy of faith in God's covenant and in the knowledge of God's blessing. God hears, He's recorded every word. I reverence God's covenant.



God's exceeding great and precious promises to me: God wants me to hear this: ⁴ My exceeding great and precious promises (2 Peter 1:4 KJV; AMPC). ⁴ Absolutely terrific promises (2 Peter 1:4 MSG). ⁴ Magnificent promises that are beyond all price (2 Peter 1:4 TPT) ⁴... these are the promises that enable you to share His divine nature and escape the world's corruption caused by human greed. In view of all this, make every effort to respond to God's promises (2 Peter 1:4 NLT).

Heavenly Storehouse: My tithing is a spiritual action. Just like my prayers come straight to God's throne and to His attention, so do my tithes. My tithe goes to the Heavenly Storehouse. They are a vital fragrance to God, a fragrant aroma of an offering and a sacrifice which God Welcomes and in which He delights (**Philippians 4:18**). God receives them personally (**Hebrews 7:8 WNT**).



God's response: This is God's response to me and my faith as a faithful tither. God see to it personally to liberally (generously) and supernaturally supply all of my needs, all of the time according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. Jesus and I have a personal connection with my tithe. I will have perfect peace in Him and I will have nothing missing and nothing broken and nothing lacking. I've got to be bold to lay hold of the promises; I have a right to these promises. "Look at these promises and prove Me now by it, if I will not": **1) open for you the**

windows of Heaven and pour you out a blessing; 2) rebuke the devourer for your sakes; 3) He shall not destroy the fruits of your ground; 4) neither shall your vine cast her fruit before the time in the field (Malachi 3:10-11 KJV). The giving of my tithe to God is a natural action, God does the supernatural. The windows of heaven speaks of supernatural abundance, increase and an outflow of God's blessing showering me in every part of my life. It's God's response to my obedience, faith and my trust in Him when I bring my tithe. God expects me to receive the promises He makes to me as a tither, I believe them and I release the force of faith out of my spirit. I'm like Abraham, **Read: Romans 4: 17-21 (MSG) (TPT).** I have the God kind of faith and I'm capable of becoming so strong that it cannot be undermined by facts, circumstances; the natural realm of reason, relevance, and reality. I welcome every promise into my heart, I believe each one of them. I release the words of these promises from within me. This is a time where the tither will shine.
