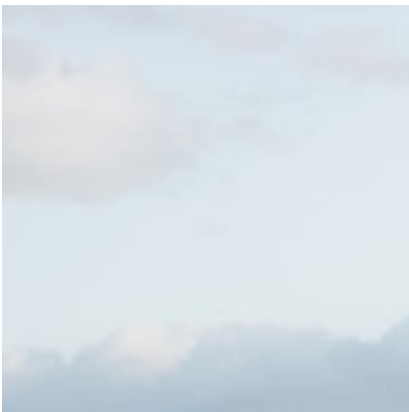
HISTORY

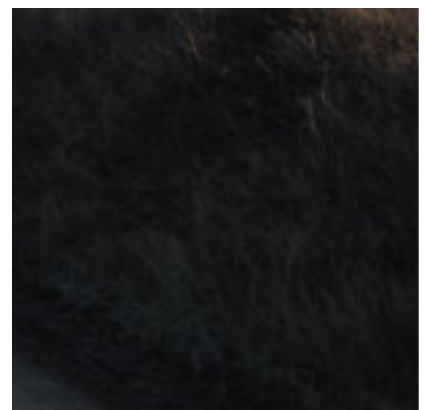
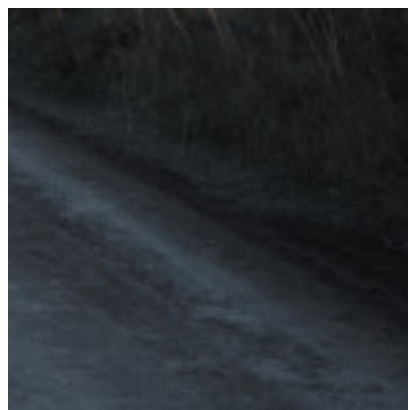
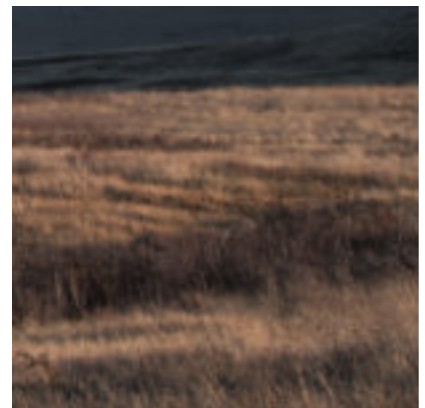
MANDATE

2022 REPORT

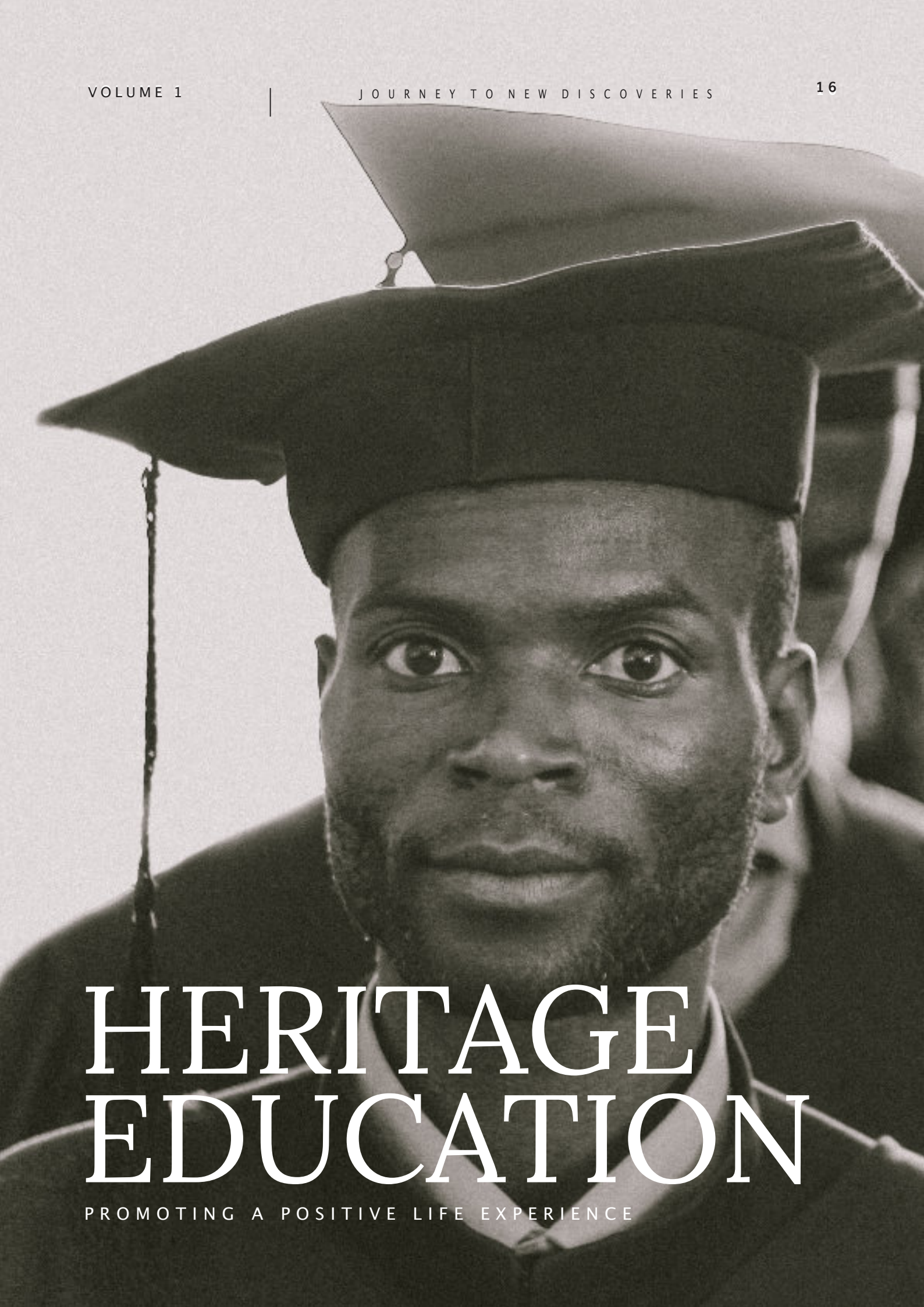

The program is supported and recognised by Jerry Savelle Ministries International with Dr Jerry Savelle as the Chancellor of Heritage of Faith Bible Institute.

Each Bible Institute is planted into a local church enabling believers to attend part time Bible classes while still enjoying participation in their local church body and community.

MiXchange – a program dedicated to the young generation to encounter God in their own personal journey, learning to live out their assignment with purpose and passion [This program is not part of HFBI].

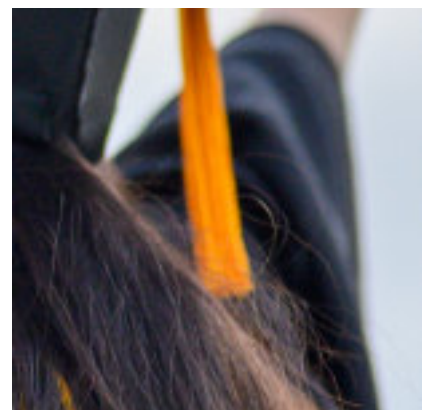
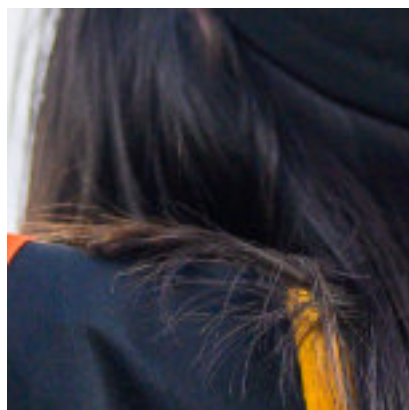
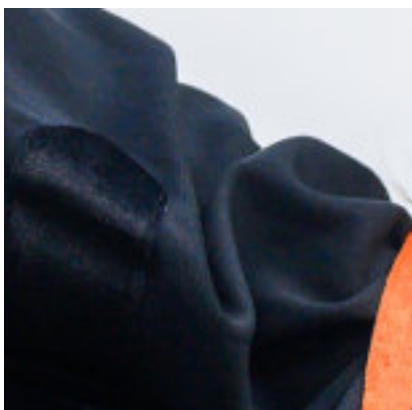


H F B I E T H I O P I A

In early 2022, Pastor John Bendixen and his team travelled to Ethiopia to establish and continue the setting up of the Jerry Savelle Bible School in that region. Meetings with the ministerial leaders of Ethiopia were held and the vision, mission and mandate of Jerry Savelle Bible School and JSMI Africa was shared. Even in a time of global pandemic, Jerry



Savelle Bible School and JSMI Africa is touching lives. "I would like to thank Dr Jerry Savelle and his ministry that is opening your Bible School in our country, Ethiopia." Many pastors and ministries are now using the material and teachings of the Jerry Savelle Bible School, we believe that as these ministries in Ethiopia continue to walk and be partnered with JSMI Africa they will experience the open hand of God and His provision for them and for their people.

Establishment of HOFMI Ethiopia as a fully-fledged legal entity within which we have now established our first campus in Addis Ababba. We also plan to develop and grow the student body, by commencing the 4th year program, Advanced Ministry Training[SOM Faculty] in 2023.

HFBI is the only Pentecostal Bible School recognised and sanctioned by the Ethiopian government, something that is unheard of.

PRACTICAL APPLICATION

This HIC program comprises three modules with a view to equipping the student for success in the marketplace, at the same time retaining spiritual priorities and values. The course contains lectures and work assignments based on eternal principles such as:

As part of Governance, a student is expected to put together a business plan covering the subject, and on several occasions, these business plans were very bankable.

The course can take the form of classroom lectures or a self-study format, and in the latter case, students meet once or twice a month to review and get further guidance through a facilitator.

One of the most tragic things that can happen to a human on earth is not death, but life without a purpose. This is evident amongst worldly people; however it becomes even more tragic amongst Christians who believe that their future is somehow preordained.

Nothing matters more than knowing God's purpose for your life, and nothing can compensate for not knowing Him. Focusing on self will never reveal your personal life assignment, only a God-purposed-education determines the values and principles of your future as well as that of your succeeding generations.

Vince Lombardi once quoted this and I have modified it slightly: "The quality of a person's life is directly proportionate to their commitment to their Godly excellence regardless of their chosen field of endeavour!"

And I add, “When one chooses to walk in your God-given assignment, committed to a Godly excellence, then it gives one purpose to unlock your divine productivity which will fulfill your ultimate covenant on earth.”

There two routes God-fearing people and students can take attending Bible school:

Studying in the field of Ministry. Here you know God has anointed you for a life in ministry and you also get to know His covenant better. Following the Heritage of Faith Institute of Commerce [HIC] route, one gets to understand how to do business God’s way for real prosperity.

HIC is a journey linking your spiritual life with the world of commerce that we live in. Only when both are aligned can our journey really start producing the divine assignment leading to our divine covenant. Our work is our worship unto God and we become fulfilled when we give Him full place in our daily lives to have a proper understanding of the authority we have in Him.

Working should be a pleasure. I have personally witnessed people’s lives changed through HIC, from promotions, or starting of their own business, to taking their business to the next level. It is also important to understand that not all people in a church will become full-time ministers, however everyone can have their own ministry through their workplace, and influence others through their success stories.

Most times you will get to minister to more people than those in the full-time ministry. Two such stories I can relate to involve both my daughters who attended HIC at different times.

The one has gone on to become a successful Director of her company, and the other, desperate for a job at the time, was given her dream work, both these incidents happened towards the later part of the course while they attended HIC.

Another testimony is attached from a student completing her 2022 studies in HIC. There is an anointing on this course for business people.

There are still many more testimonies of people who have completed this course and they have personally experienced how powerful the full anointing is carried through the life and Founder of HIC, Pastor John Bendixen, which is transferred to the students.

The E-reader project was launched in 2013 with 150 E-readers. Fifty in Zambia and fifty in Malawi. We graduated students in both Malawi and Zambia.

The E-reader project had some shortcomings which needed to be rectified. SD cards were stolen, E-readers were broken, cracked screens, no way to charge them in rural areas and batteries failing are some of the problems. We needed to get the material to the lectures that could teach others while learning at the same time. This gave birth to the HFBA in 2015.

We soon realised that if we wanted to get the Bible Academy to be relevant, we needed to start "Satelite Bible Academies." We started with Rumphu, Karonga, Wiliro, Chitipa and Lilongwe in Malawi. In Zambia we started in Livingstone and in Botswana we started in Serowe. We also had HFBA's in Rumphu and Mzuzu.

In 2019 we graduated students in 17 BA's with/- 450 students of which more than a hundred are in the prisons.

We now have 81 Bible Academies in Malawi, 12 in Zambia, 1 in Mozambique, 1 in Swaziland, 1 in DRC and 1 in Tanzania.

We have graduated 3400 students in 2022 backdating to 2020.

Ps Lynn had the wisdom to develop a more suitable program which would not diminish our Bible School standard.

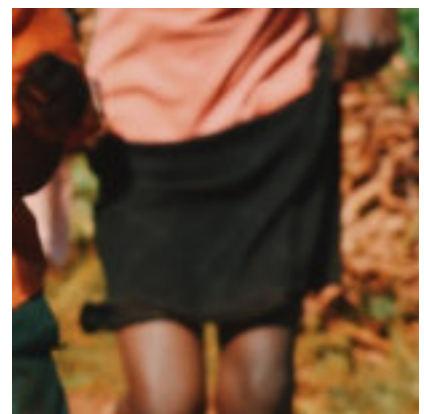

Our mission is to serve these children, giving them a chance in life by providing basic necessities and support in their local education – facilitated through the compassion and care of our volunteers. A monthly financial seed is sown by the ministry which contributes to the staff salaries & household expenses (electricity, food, toiletries, fuel, etc). Currently, there are 11 children being cared for in Heritage House, between the ages of 6 and 16. All of these children are cared for by three ‘moms’ – who make sure all of their needs are being met. The MiXchangers & missionary visits are key for relationship building; providing an opportunity for touch-base conversations, relationship building, support, play-time, fun activities & lifestyle improvements.

SPRING VALLEY - LOCAL COMMUNITY PROJECT

SERVING OUR LOCAL COMMUNITY

Spring Valley is an informal settlement in close proximity to the Witbank Heritage of Faith campus. As a part of local missions, there is a team in place that serves this local community; building trust and sharing the love of Jesus.

Part of our service is to equip the current volunteers living in Spring Valley, these volunteers serve the community, by visiting every home once a month to become soul winners and to create a platform with this for congregation members also to participate in soul winning and serving.





2022 SEED PROJECTS

We are actively participating in a food scheme where approximately 60 people are being provided meals three times a week. We have engaged community volunteers to prepare these meals for the unemployed, elderly, ill and bedridden. We took a team of volunteers to help with repairs to the church building & toilets. The church building in Spring Valley is being utilised as temporary classrooms for the primary school. Spring Valley has a serious challenge supplying the local community with water and we provide continuous participation and involvement to solve the lack of potable water in the area.

BreakFree is a program focused in bringing people back to a disciplined way of living, encouraging them to change and positively impact those around them. We aim to support both the addicts & their families who have been negatively impacted by their addiction. BreakFree is committed to our Lord Jesus and puts God first as the counsellors and facilitators assist people in their recovery from substance abuse through the safe accommodation, therapy, and all practical live-in assistance that is provided. Building on-site schooling facilities, better quality services and sanitation are but some of the initiatives intended to improve their standard of living and recovery.

THE ECCLESIA

The Church of the Lord Jesus

REFERENCE: "A LIGHT IN THE DARKNESS" BY RICK RENNER

This word 'church' is a Greek word 'ekklesia.' It describes an entire assembly of individuals who are called out, called forth and separated and who hold a position of honour and privilege.

This Greek word 'ekklesia' has a rich and meaningful history that few understand. The earliest appearance of this word was in ancient Athens where it was used only in a political context. This early meaning of 'ekklesia' is significant because it was still very much in force when Jesus used this particular word.

He did not say I will build My synagogue, He particularly said I will build My 'ekklesia.' There is no doubt that the writers of the New Testament clearly understood the meaning of the word 'ekklesia' – a meaning far more profound than the one attributed today to its modern counterpart 'Church.'

Anyone with a sound knowledge of the Greek language in the first century – and certainly this would include the apostle Paul. He would have understood the historical, political and judicial implications connected to this word.

In Classical Greece, the word 'ekklesia' denoted an assembly of citizens who were invited to participate in a closed assembly in Athens. At this assembly a variety of political functions were performed: Laws were created.

Key judicial cases were decided. Governmental decisions were debated. Policies affecting both internal and external affairs were formulated. Customs and cultural norms were adapted and

changed. State decisions were proclaimed. Officials were appointed. Every Athenian citizen was invited to attend the meeting and participate in this ruling body, regardless of his class or status in society – however only citizens could attend. Delegates were "called out" from their private lives and "summoned" to take their seats in this distinguished assembly.

People counted it a great privilege and honor to participate in this illustrious body. Its decisions were so far reaching that they affected every aspect of public and private life. These meetings were conducted 30 to 40 times a year. The 'ekklesia' had different levels of leadership. The council operated when the 'ekklesia' was not in session. This council then determined what would be brought before the people at the next general assembly [ekklesia].

In many respects, the levels of leadership in the Athenian 'ekklesia' were similar to the various levels of leadership that later emerged in the New Testament local Church.

As citizens of God's Kingdom, all the believers have the right to participate in the affairs and the life of the church. Just as the Athenian 'ekklesia' ruled in matters of law, business, society, customs, culture and judicial matters, God calls upon the local Church to exert its influence in every arena of the society in which it exists.

It was never God's intention for the local church to be a group of silent, unnoticed people who gather to sing songs and listen to inspirational messages, take up offerings and go home. This power packed

Greek word clearly tells us that God's original intent was that each local Church have a powerful impact on society.

Thus, the scriptural concept of the word 'ekklesia' can be said to be: A body of believers who are citizens of Heaven and are called to do business for God on the earth. To apply God's laws in the affairs of earth. To bring God's Kingdom as it is in Heaven to be on earth. To rule and reign on His behalf in the earth. Gods' Legitimate Legislative Assembly on the earth.

In Paul's writings the word 'ekklesia' most often refers to a visible church located in a real geographical location. To the church at Corinth, he was not writing to a worldwide body of believers, rather, he was addressing a specific congregation, with concrete needs and issues, located in a specific city.

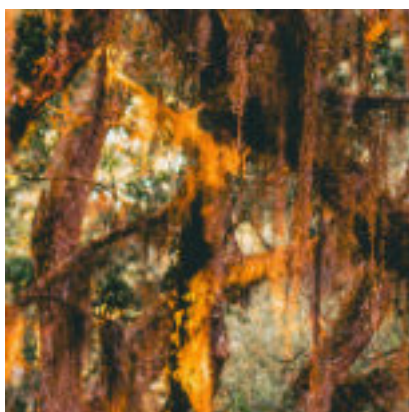
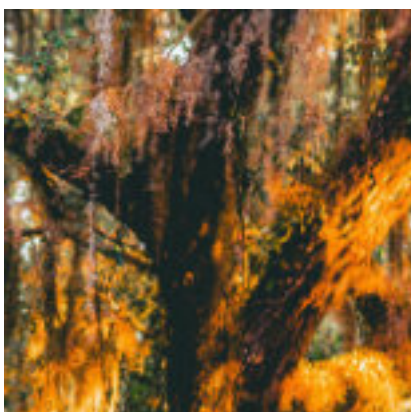

To help parents transition from a corrupt system of education into God's pure and holy ways of teaching and training. This can be done through practical help (to be determined) and also through teaching and training from the church.



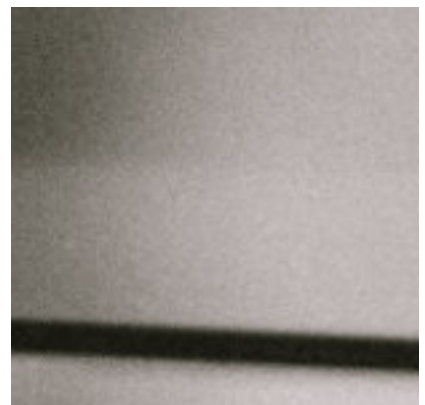
MISSION

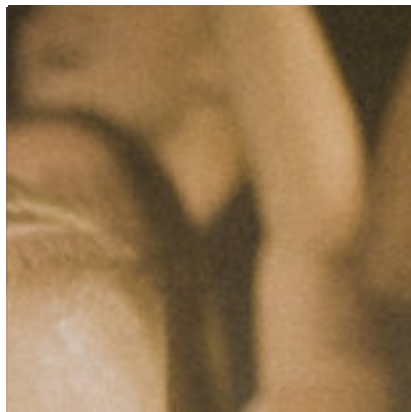



I have been on a personal journey in sound and song for as long as I can remember. I grew up in a Christian home where both my parents were musical and there was always piano playing and singing happening in the home.

My parents were also pastors and so music in our church was also alive and active in my personal time with the Lord, I have for many years enjoyed to sing songs of adoration to Him – both known songs and spontaneous songs to Him as well.

When my husband and I were called into pastoral ministry, the Lord's primary requirement for me was to help Ps John to teach and disciple the people and also to activate, organise and establish corporate prayer.

From 2000 until 2017 my involvement in music ministry was quite light and I mainly ensured that the words that we sang as a congregation were faith and Bible filled words. I had learned from our spiritual father Kenneth E Hagin that a lot of songs are filled with unbelief and that one wouldn't want to sing to the Lord what one wouldn't necessarily want to say to Him.

In 2017 the Lord spoke quite suddenly and certainly to me and said: "I am holding you personally responsible for the SPIRITUALITY of MY Music Ministry."

I took this to Pastor John as I was not quite sure what to do with it. It was a few weeks later that Pastor John suddenly and certainly announced to the congregation from the pulpit on a Sunday morning; He said: "As of this morning, Pastor Sharon will be operating as the chief psalmist of this ministry. The fullness of time has come and now we are obedient."

He had up till that point had no personal conversations with me concerning this. It was both surprising and challenging to me as it meant me moving out of a very comfortable rhythm that I had been in for 17 years. It felt to me like I had been thrown into the deep end but the Lord immediately began to speak to me and He reminded me of a word He had given in recent years... "Sharon, the ministry of psalmist will not go undone."

I was comforted and encouraged greatly by the Lord that this was indeed His plan for me at this exact time. The emphasis that the Lord had given me was, "SPIRITUALITY." I knew that I was to seek the Lord both in the Word and in prayer. That I was to receive from the Holy Spirit that which He wanted to orchestrate on behalf of the Father in our Church.

To say that revelation knowledge began to flow is an understatement. A barrage of revelation from the Lord and from His precious Holy written Word began to flood my heart and continues still to this day as I continue to press into Him for everything His heart desires for His music ministry!

Everything shifted...as the Lord began to require the people in the music ministry to step up their spiritual life in Him (especially the singers). Some people chose to step down and others left the Church. This was not the Lord's choice but He was immovable on the 'spiritual' increase He desired from us.

It became crystal clear that what He meant by the people in the music ministry being spiritual was that they would come to prayer meetings and pray...be at every service listening to His every Word and obeying all He was saying to us as a church, that they were to be true sons and daughters of the local church planted and faithful in all spiritual things.

He began to show me that people in the music ministry think that what applies to the rest of the people does not apply to them. They can take time out after they have played and sang, they can go walkabout and then enter the service at their convenience. They want to sing in public but they have no song to Him in the secret place with Him.

Ps John made a powerful statement that rocked my whole world...On the whole in the Church of the Lord Jesus Christ the music causes people to HAVE AN INTERACTIVE SOUL EXPERIENCE. I began to understand from the word 'responsible for the spirituality' that the music is for the Lord and not only for the people.

God is a Spirit and He receives songs and sounds from those who are spirits. He began to very clearly show us that He wanted to be personally involved in showing us all things in HIS music ministry.

We understood that He wanted to give us spiritual songs to sing where we would have a spiritual experience and encounter with Him. He gave us very clear direction that we were to let go of all songs that we got from other musicians... even the 'popular' ones. He started from scratch with us... it certainly scratched some people but as soon as the teaching flowed people started to get with God's purpose. He was clear that in this house we were to have the sound and the songs with Him and from Him.

So my role and understanding of my personal assignment with Pastor John in Heritage Music Ministry is crystal clear. Our joint calling in this ministry is to ask of the people. What is the point of being a Christian? The answer is: to be spiritual.

The next question is: what is the point of being spiritual? So that we can bring heaven to earth. So my part with Pastor John in Sound and Song is to fulfil this mandate i.e. to be responsible for the SPIRITUALITY in music ministry. This is done by praying in the Spirit, receiving revelation from His Word, receiving instructions from the Holy Spirit and being obedient to Him with boldness and humility.

My highlight discovery in Sound and Song this year has been to experience the increase of the manifest Presence of the Lord with us in our times of Song and Sound together. There is a level of understanding in the hearts of the people concerning Music Ministry and therefore a greater participation and cooperation with the flow of the Holy Spirit when He moves in us and among us. We are growing in knowing each other after the spirit...there is an ease with which we flow, there is no shadow intercepting the light the Lord is bringing.

On this journey we see that Sound and Song is going deeper and deeper into the rich things that the Lord has reserved in heaven for us. What our spiritual eyes have not yet seen we will see. What our spiritual ears have not yet heard we will hear. What has not yet entered our hearts yet spiritually and musically the Holy Spirit will continue to take us from one degree of glory to another. We see our organised and established prayer time that we have for music ministry increasing and intensifying.

We fully expect the Lord to continue to give us everything He has in His heart for His music ministry. This is what we fully expect more and more of. We expect the Lord to bring everyone that He has designed to come into music ministry. To fully come.



We expect His timing and their spiritual preparation to collide. We expect the more He has for us in all aspects spiritually, musically, instrumentally, vocally and creatively...the Glory the Glory the Glory!

Music Ministry includes songs and sounds that minister to the Lord. Music ministry includes our praise to Him which we sing. Music ministry includes the worship in our hearts to Him which we bring when we sing. But sound and song is so much more.

The Lord wanted us to get a broader wider deeper perspective by leading us to use new words – sound and song in music ministry.

He is helping us to get away from old paradigms which have been instilled in us in the last era when someone coined a phrase 'Praise and worship' for the Music Ministry of the Lord.

He who controls the language controls the culture. He wants to do a new thing now in this new era through a new open door and it helps Heritage of Faith people to open our hearts and minds so that we can more readily expect and receive and flow with His new things He has for us!

What is your role in Heritage Worship?

My role has been defined as "psalmist" in that I write songs out of a personal relationship with God and His Word. Pastor John is called by God to build the house of Lord and Heritage Worship is one of the points of construction within the house of the Lord. With this in mind I endeavour to serve God and Pastor John in the building of music ministry so that it may give glory to God and be excellent for Him.

What growth have you witnessed in Sound & Song at HOF?

Psalms 127:1 – Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain. This scripture has and will continue to be the foundation upon which we will build music ministry with God. We do not want to labour in vain and build something that is not pleasing to God. So just the simple fact of asking God what He wants has been a growing point for all of us in Heritage Worship. We have asked God for the words, the messages, the chords and the sounds that best deliver the message in every song. Constructing music in this way has revealed just how impacted we have been by secular Christian music as well as secular music. There was and is some "unlearning" still to occur in order to build and grow the way God desires. This process requires faith and trust in God. In many occasions we have had to wait on the Lord for His leading and this has brought growth in faith, trust and also patience. The growth in these things are what has been most valuable to us in Heritage Worship and for which we praise God.

What your creative process when composing new songs?

If I am writing a song based on a Psalm or a scripture I will ask the Holy Spirit about the chords and sounds that best fit the tone of the words. Sometimes I will play a few different chord progressions and ask Holy Spirit which sound fits the words. Sometimes there is a chord progression or a piano riff that I like and Holy Spirit will direct me as to which Psalm, scripture or message best fits with that sound or riff. There have been 2 occasions where God will give me words and He directs my fingers to write words and then He also gives me the chords, sounds and melody that fits the words. This is the exception however. In most situations the construction of a song is very similar to that of most artistry, one stroke at a time until the full picture is revealed.

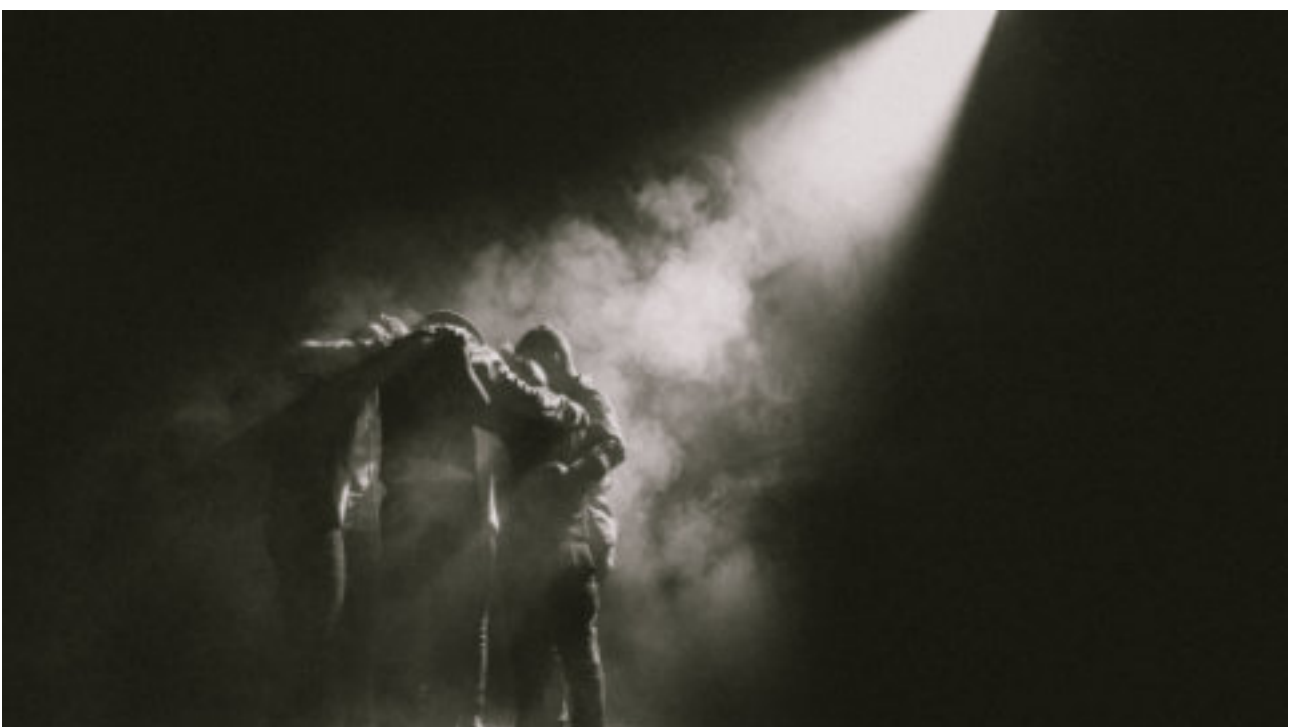
What is your highlight discovery on this inspirational journey?

I have discovered that God is far more interested in the heart of the person singing the song than the complexity of the song itself. If I or any person is not truly worshipping God from their lives and their hearts, then the words and the feelings that the song evokes means very little. God wants our hearts and the words we sing to be living in our hearts. When we worship Him like this, in spirit and in truth we bless Him and glorify Him.


"My journey through the media department from when I joined Heritage of Faith has been an exciting one to watch unfold and see how the department has developed.

I have had the privilege of being a part of the repurposing and re-establishing of the Heritage Foundation, although it is still early days – the Heritage Foundation has an exciting future ahead. It has been re-established as a foundation that will become known as a worthy platform upon which donors from all over the world will be able to contribute their resources purposed for the service of God and man.

Ps John is called to be on assignment with Dr Jerry in Africa. In the context of the Heritage Foundation and my functioning therein – I believe I may be able to assist Ps John and Dr Jerry in the effective execution of the mandate of the foundation as well as acting as a responsible liaison between

donors and beneficiaries, carrying God's heart and vision for the foundation as my own and establishing this with the necessary stakeholders. I am also able to assist with the financial advisory of resources – endeavouring to steward with excellence.

A highlight for me regarding the foundation has been the re-igniting and revamping of the foundation – establishing it as both an appealing and eligible steward for the purpose of conduiting resources for the Kingdom of God – this was demonstrated in the leather bound book that was custom made for prospective partners.

To sustainably partner with projects that significantly impact the youth in a faith based manner helping them live a positive life experience.

To help bring generations together through projects that harness and direct the energy of the young and bring stability through wisdom and experience from those who are older.

To support projects that encourage good health and longevity through sports, fitness and excellent nutrition.

Contribute to the monthly existential expenses for a youth home in Witbank as well as a drug rehabilitation centre near Pretoria.

Fund the development of a grass roots Learning Centre for children of all ages.

To fund the ongoing development of and growth of MiXchange, a programme for youth who have come out of school and are seeking God's plan for their lives.

Sports Club



Slipstream is an outreach of HOFMI that aims to meaningfully touch people of the broader community without being marketed as a 'church club.' It is also an outlet for HOFMI people to condition their physical bodies because there's a direct connection in having a conditioned attitude about your body and your spirit life because your spirit man wants to control what your body does and the desires and appetites of your body, so that it lives strong and healthy and that it lives in a way that promotes your ability to live in the fullness of God.

Slipstream branches into 2 sections: Slipstream and Slipstream Sports Club.

Slipstream as an umbrella organisation to Slipstream Sports Club, helps power all the various activities of Slipstream Sports Club through creative ideas, human resources and technology based solutions. This opens up the scope of the reach of the organisation to working with other organisations or events but also collaborating with various other sport entities to provide a greater platform to reach out to the community.

Past projects of Slipstream include the hosting and powering of The Waterlectric Running Race in collaboration with the Emalaheni Local Municipality. The designing and building of the RunUp, which is a local community based weekly timed running event as a 'parkrun' alternative. Slipstream has designed, built and deployed both the online platform and application to facilitate this event.

Slipstream Sports Club, a club purposed to establish relationships, uniting people through physical activity both IN-PERSON and ONLINE! Slipstream is a community that provides a service of group activities and doable monthly virtual challenges that motivates and inspires people to get fitter.

Slipstream Sports Club is a registered club and affiliated with Athletics South Africa, Cycling South Africa and Triathlon South Africa – allowing for the hosting of sanctioned events and distribution of racing licences to athletes.

Initially, growth seemed very slow. But during COVID, God used the pandemic to explode Slipstream. We've gone from below 20 members, to over 200 people engaging in monthly Slipstream Challenges, in a matter of days.

The Slipstream presence in both the Witbank and online community is still strong and continues to grow. Not only has Slipstream gone from a club that only sells licences, but we've hosted and participated in multiple events, we've gained access to the Witbank Nature Reserve and Resort (something that no other entity has ever done) and we're in the process of starting our own version of "Park Run" – The RunUp.

The trajectory Slipstream is currently on is onward and upwards, with God. The possibilities are endless – events, bringing communities together, bettering lifestyles, but most of all, another tool that God can use to reach people and save lives.

“Before I joined I was doing a little bit of pilates here and there but far and in between. My physical fitness was quite low, I would say my flexibility was good but I wasn’t doing any cardio or strength training whatsoever. My physical condition was not too great.

In 2022, I participated in the Race to the Sun and cycled 80km on a bicycle which was one of my milestones for the year and then cycled another 20km on a bicycle the next day at the Ultra Triathlon with my sisters (who swam and ran).

A big part of my cycling journey included going to Dullstroom and cycling +34km per day for 2 days and climbing elevations that were quite intense (for me). This was quite a challenge for me, even more so than the Race to the Sun because I wasn’t used to the high elevations. But it taught me a lot about how to approach my training, to not only focus on distance and being saddle-fit but also to work on elevation milestone that work both your legs and cardio.

Another milestone I still have towards the latter part of 2022 is running a 10km. For the last 4 weeks, I have been training to run 5km 4 times a week, working up my cardio and heart rate milestones to do 10km. By November I would like to do another 70km on the bicycle, which because of my focus on running will be a challenge for me.

My motivation is the Word and will of God to keep our bodies healthy and in a condition that will increase longevity. Improving my condition is important to me because I realise I am not yet at the level that is maintainable, or at least I am not maintaining it to the degree that I would like to.

I know, for instance, I can increase my cardio and work towards lowering my maximum heart rate while exercising. Even though this does not affect my daily living, I realise that without maintaining a certain level in my conditioning, I have to keep making up for the maintenance that was lost which means improving my conditioning gets interrupted and takes longer to do (However, sometimes these interruptions are legitimate because of surges in the ministry).

I enjoy conditioning together as a group. Personally, getting up to exercise by myself is my biggest challenge. I enjoy getting together to train together because it motivates and excites me to see others making the same commitment that I am making. As well as having others that are growing towards the same milestones that I am.

I can talk to them about those milestones and train with them, which certainly boosts my desire to be up early to condition. I don’t really find myself training beyond what we do together and perhaps that is something I need to work on, therefore my conditioning only takes place within the group.”

Slipstream hosted and participated in many events in 2022!

The Waterelectric race, a Slipstream first and a Witbank first! For walkers and runners, the race was held at the Emalahleni Nature Reserve –with a 4.9km route that was family friendly and a 15km route for the more serious runners. 170 runners took part, with over 300 people in attendance on the day.

Slipstream was contacted by the Emalahleni Municipality to support their 10km Fun Run and Slipstream helped in the route markings, organisation and managing of the race that took place at the Nature Reserve. We were so grateful to offer a helping hand to our local municipality and building relationship with our mayor!

Slipstream also joined and lent a helping hand in the opening of Franschkloof, a dedicated place for cyclists and runners, Slipstream created the routes and dug out the tracks on the farm –spending many hours in the blazing sun, spades in hand. Slipstream also hosts monthly Crit's for cyclists – a 1,6km route, with the goal of doing as many laps as you can in an hour. The Crit's have great attendance and participation from the local community.

“Before I joined Slipstream Sports Club I was trying to go to the gym and run a bit on and off but was never able to keep consistent therefore I never saw results.

When I first joined Slipstream we were given the options of different milestones we could work towards. I chose to start training for the “Sprint Triathlon” which is a 600m swim, 20km cycle and a 5km all in one! When I first chose this I had no idea if I'd actually be able to complete something like that. But as I stayed consistent in my training, I started to become a lot more fit and started to feel as if I could do this race.

I must say that consistently training improved my physical life. I found I had a lot more energy and felt a lot stronger in my body. Mentally I was a lot happier with where I was in my health and scientifically exercise increases happiness. And also spiritually.

I completed the triathlon in 2 hours, 7 Minutes and 3.4 seconds. It's something I would have never thought of doing before and I wouldn't have been able to complete it if it wasn't for the way Slipstream has supported me.

What's motivating me to improve my condition is the other members in Slipstream that keep me accountable to keeping my goals. It's me wanting to become stronger and feel better and healthier in my physical body. And we have a long ride coming up soon that is motivating me to improve in my cycling.

I'm thinking of doing the 70km cycle at Alzu. And we have a 21km run coming up in January that is motivating me to stay consistent with my running as well.

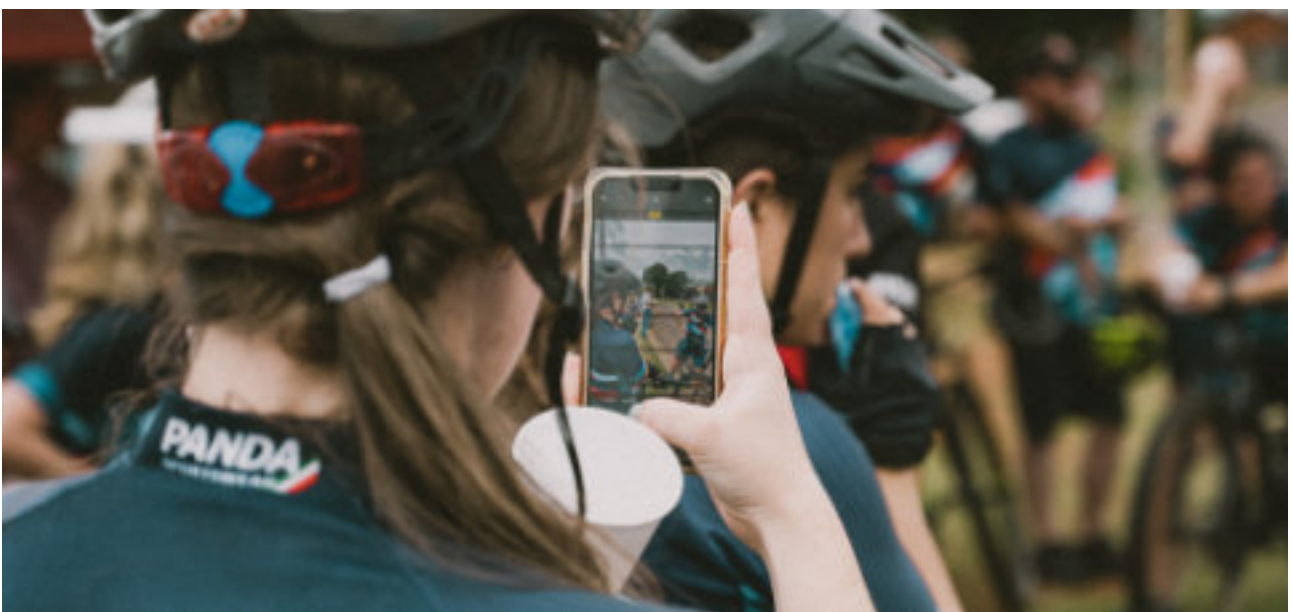
